

PROTOCOL FOR SMALL GROUP MEETINGS AT LIFESPRING CHURCH DURING COVID PANDEMIC

Definition of Small Group—10 or fewer people

- 1. Each participant will be respectful of others and stay home if running a fever, sick, or feeling “under the weather”. Each participant will also stay home if he/she has had a known or suspected exposure to Covid.**
- 2. Each participant will wear a mask while in the building.**
- 3. Each participant will perform hand hygiene upon entering the building, and as needed during the meeting. Hand sanitizer will be available at the front door and in the meeting room.**
- 4. Social distancing of at least 6 feet will be practiced throughout the meeting. The room selected for the meeting will be appropriate for the size of group in order to maintain 6 feet separation.**
- 5. No food will be served or brought into the meeting. Participants may bring their own drink into the meeting, but will be responsible for removing/disposing of it after the meeting.**
- 6. Group activity will not include singing, but listening to music is acceptable.**
- 7. Participants will not share items, ie pens, pencils, books. If hand outs are distributed during the meeting, each participant will take their copy with them when they leave.**
- 8. The group leader will be responsible for cleaning commonly touched surfaces at the end of the meeting, ie door handles, light switches, table tops with an approved disinfectant.**
- 9. A dated list of attendees will be kept of each meeting to facilitate contact tracing if it became necessary.**
